This year we can once again gather (within the Provincial Health guidelines) and so you can choose to *brave the frigid waters of the Atlantic Oce*an with the **'Plunge in the Park' challenge.** This event will take place in-person in the morning on **Sunday, April 24**th at **Dalvay Beach** in the PEI National Park.

If you choose to plunge-in-person, you will receive an email the week of April 17th with more detailed information about the in-person event including the time to arrive, your attestation form to complete and return and any protocols that will need to be followed the day of.

Maybe running into the *frigid Atlantic Ocean* isn't very appealing to you? We understand and invite you to put your thinking cap on for unique ways to take the **Virtual Plunge Challenge**.

We will even make it easy for you to get your creative juices flowing and be sure to check out our Facebook event page and website for great videos and tips throughout the weeks leading up to and after the event:

- **Get Sprayed** run through the sprinklers outside or ask someone to turn the hose on you (like our SOPEI coach, Jamie Matheson did at the firehall last year) -be sure to video your *Freezin' for a Reason!*
- Water fight outside, so as not to make a mess, and keep safety in mind but think water balloons or squirt guns don't forget to record your event for your supporters to see and enjoy! How about a National or Global one...
- Cool Down inside in the tub with your swim attire or costume on and take a quick cold shower while you or a friend records it – or someone can dump a bucket/glass of water or ice cubes on you
- Get Creative in the past SOPEI Athlete, Tommy Ling, slid into his plunge and a kiddy pool of cold water
- Pools or Open Water we had some brave plungers running into the cold waters for last year's virtual event while a friend recorded it
